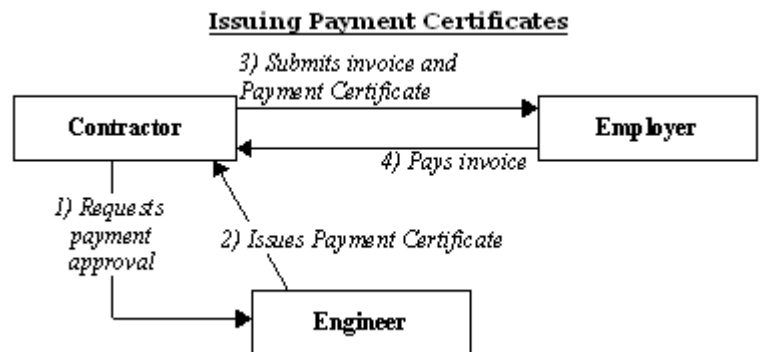


CONSULTING ENGINEERS:

GENERATED DOCUMENTS

With Clipcode Knowledge Networks, you can generate these documents:

- **Advance Payment Certificate** - upfront payment to the contractor. May also be issued after increases in section prices following a Variation Order
- **Interim Payment Certificate** - usually issued monthly, ongoing payments to the contractor for certified completion of work
- **Taking-Over Payment Certificate** - when the Employer takes over a Section of Works
- **Final Payment Certificate** - last payment to complete payment for one or more Sections Of Works
- **Customs Payment Certificate** - In some countries, Customs & Import Duties need to be calculated separated and claimed for via their own payment certificates
- **Certificate Attachment** - Generated along with each Payment Certificate, this attachment shows detailed payment status for all Sections Of Works
- **Subsection Attachment** - drilldown into the payment status of the subsections of a single Section of Works
- **Customs Attachment** – Lists individual Customs payments
- **Variation Order Attachment** - Unified view of changes to the contract pricing after a Variation Order

- **Creating Sections Of Works and their subsections**
- **Sections of Works may be re-priced, added and removed in a Variation Order**
- **Sections of Works are divided into Committed Sums and Provisional Sums**
- **A certificate can be recalled, edited and re-issued.**
- **A certificate can be created and issued even while a variation order is being prepared**
- **Recovery follows a VO that reduces/deletes a section for which payment has already been made and allows monies to be recovered on the next payment certificate**
- **Diversions allows payments to be moved between Sections of Works (e.g. a piece of equipment that has been paid for in one Section Of Works will now be used in a different Section Of Works).**
- **Single currency and dual currency documents are supported**
- **Currencies with different subunit counts, including those with three places of decimal (e.g. Bahrain Dinar - BD123.456) with those with none (e.g. Yen – Y123)**
